Dear Friends of Rochelle Community Hospital,

The last fiscal year has been one of renewed vibrancy at the hospital. The hallways were once again busy with patients. Staff and visitors were out from behind closed doors with the worst of the pandemic behind us. Your community hospital continued to put the safety and wellbeing of every one of you at the forefront during this time. I am proud of the work that has been done and continues to be done each and every day to serve the Rochelle community.

Even in the shadow of a pandemic, the hospital continued its commitment of making improvements to its infrastructure. We went live with a new electronic medical record on May 1, 2022. Both the hospital and the Family Healthcare Clinic switched to the Epic platform. Epic is the premiere electronic medical record across the country and provides improved connectivity internally as well as externally. This new medical record makes medical information available between your healthcare providers, which enhances your healthcare experience.

We also made a significant improvement to our MRI in December of 2022. With the addition of the Canon Encore Vantage Orian, there were significant functional enhancements including clearer images, reduction of imaging noise and 40% reduction in exam times. In addition to our full service of exams, we have added the capability of breast MRI. We are pleased to offer state of the art imaging to our patients.

Recruitment efforts continued in full swing during this fiscal year. Harrison (Hank) Swalla, MPAS, PA-C joined XCEL Orthopedics as Physician Assistant in late August. The addition of a PA to Dr. Delisca's practice has added more clinic time as well as trained assistance in the operating room.

To round out our recruitment efforts we have contracted with a Doctor of Osteopathy (DO), Graham Isaacson. Dr. Isaacson completed his DO at Midwestern University, Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine in 2021 with anticipated completion of his residency in June of 2024. We are excited for the addition of Dr. Isaacson next year to our Family Healthcare Clinic.

This fiscal year has been one of renewed optimism. Our financial position continues to be strong and we are dedicated to providing high quality services to our friends and neighbors in Rochelle and surrounding communities. Our mission and vision will continue to be our guide and our success will be found in service to you.

We feel the community support each time you trust us with your care or the care of your loved ones.




